Make a Positive Impact at the Boys & Girls Club

Join the staff and kids at Southside, Roosevelt or Eastside Boys & Girls club unit as a program volunteer! You can make a difference in a child's life in as little as one hour a week. Set your own schedule with the Volunteer Coordinator to make your experience valuable. They have opportunities for you to get involved in the areas of education and career development, character and leadership, the arts, health and life skills, sports, fitness and recreation. Play board games with kids, read one-to-one with a child or help with homework, participate in gym activities, share your love of arts and crafts or shoot pool with teens. It's as easy as spending time with kids. They ask volunteers to be able to relate well with children in a group environment, participate as an active team member with staff and other volunteers. Must be able to pass a background check (fee of \$13 to the volunteers). They require a minimum commitment of 20 hours over a three month period.

How to apply: volunteer need to go through an enrollment process which includes orientation. All Volunteers are asked to complete a criminal background check before their first volunteer experience.
